Dear HPCA members,

With spring just around the corner (really I am not kidding!) I offer this update on Hartung Park and the HPCA board's activities.

Mark your calendars for Sunday June 6, 2010 at 1pm for our Annual Meeting and our Grand Opening and Dedication of Hartung Park. We hope you can join us! It is time to celebrate all our hard work!

We also hope you will join us for our **neighborhood Earth Day event on Saturday April 17**. We will be collecting metal household items with Action Recyclers as a fundraiser for the park. We hope you will start to set items aside for our event. If you would like to help with this event please contact me. A list of accepted items follows on the next page of this letter.

As you probably noticed much of the park is complete but there are a couple of projects that will be happening this spring/early summer:

- 1) Installation of the Silurian reef environmental education and art display. This will involve installing on the rocky hillside 7 bronze sculptures designed by local artist Laura Priebe and purchased with grants from the Greater Milwaukee Foundation, Lubar Family, and the DNR. In addition three interpretive signs will be installed with information about the geologic, biologic, and cultural history of the Hartung Park area. Those have been prepared by local residents Mike Cape and Jason Wilke with the assistance of experts at the public museum and at UWM. They are paid for by a grant from We Energies Foundation. We will also have 2 picnic tables added to the park this spring, a gift from Lowe's store on Burleigh and 124th St.
- 2) Building of the pond and installation of the labyrinth on the SW section of the park area. This project will be paid for in full by a state grant. It helps the city of Milwaukee meet its requirements under new state rules for handling of storm water and runoff. Great efforts are being made to maximize safety and aesthetic appeal in its design.

We continue to fundraise with the goal of adding a couple of small spinners to the one remaining open area in the playground. At the annual meeting we will provide a financial and planning update.

Finally, I would like to extend my appreciation to our many volunteers and board members. We have a very active board and I feel lucky to have the opportunity to work with such fine neighbors. None of us had a true grasp of the size of this project and the kind of time and skill demands it would make on us. But as a team we always seem to have someone among us or in the neighborhood that can meet the next challenge, and do so with skill and grace. Thank you to our volunteers!
