- This seems to be a good way to finance park but I would not want the city to use eminent domain to take the property.
- Lets try to eliminate those four family apartments.

- Why new houses 2000 square feet when houses on 99th ST are less than 1000 square feet.
 - No multifamily homes and new houses should be no less than 2000 square feet. No alleys, driveways preferred.
 - The apartment complexes detract from the houses that are trying to make the neighborhood nice.
 - Detail better with finance and wear runoff implications.
 - Groundwater (storm water) runoff is a big concern; 24-foot elevation is too high.
